The prophet of the Lord and the prophet's loyal servant: united in the Word of God; bound in life in the land (Jews) and life in exile (Gentiles); protological Jeremiah and his faithful servant await the eschatological Jeremiah and his faithful servants as ministers of the Word of God to Jew and Gentile, in fulfillment of the Word of Jeremiah of old.
