  - 5. Shows hands and side (v. 20a)
  - 6. Disciples response—see "the Lord" (v. 20b)
  - 7. "Jesus said" (vv. 21-23)
- A'. Disciples, "We have seen the Lord" (vv. 24-25)
- B'. Appearance to Thomas (vv. 26-29)
  - 1. Time reference ("after eight days," v. 26)
  - 2. Disciples gathered; door shut (v. 26b)
  - 3. Jesus came and stood (v. 26c)
  - 4. "Peace be to you" (v. 26d)
  - 5. Touch hands and side (v. 27)
  - 6. Thomas's response—"My Lord and my God" (v. 28)
  - 7. "Jesus said" (v. 29)
